PsychINFO – The most prominent database is the field of Psychology.

Start your searches using the Advanced Search screen.

For literature searches, it's most effective to use subject terms, or descriptors, in order to view articles related to your topic. Find descriptors using the thesauri. Use the SEARCH TOOLS tab to access the Thesaurus.

Try searching for your topic in the Thesaurus. My term was not found, but the closest terms were listed. If you don't find your term, try searching the Alphabetical or Rotated index, in "select display."

Use AND to narrow

Use OR to broaden

After choosing the closest term, Environmental Effects, I'm taken to the term, and given the definition, in addition to the narrower (more refined) and related terms.
