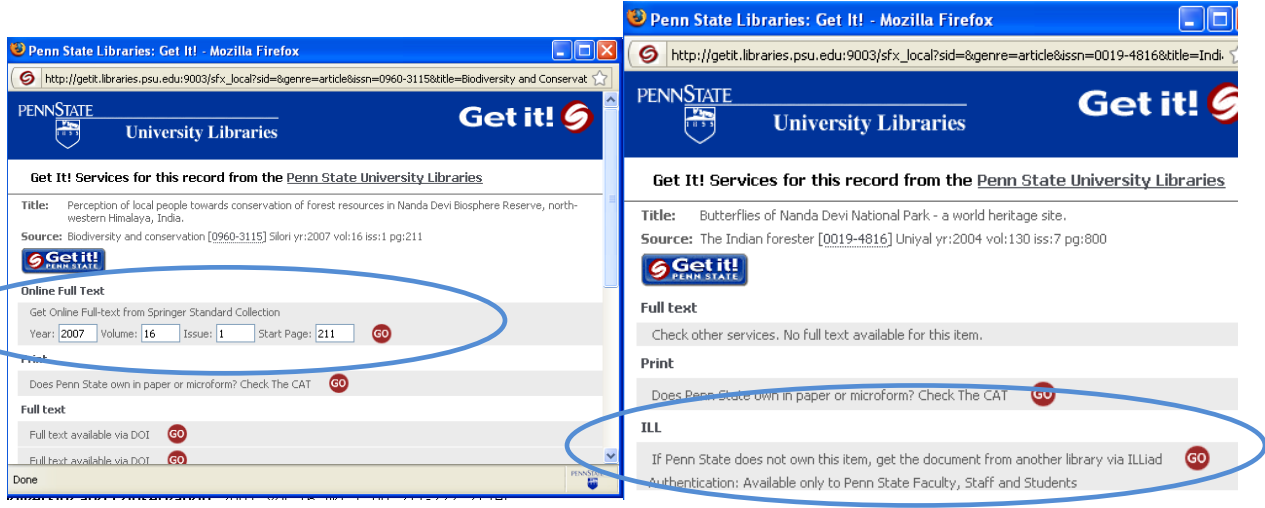
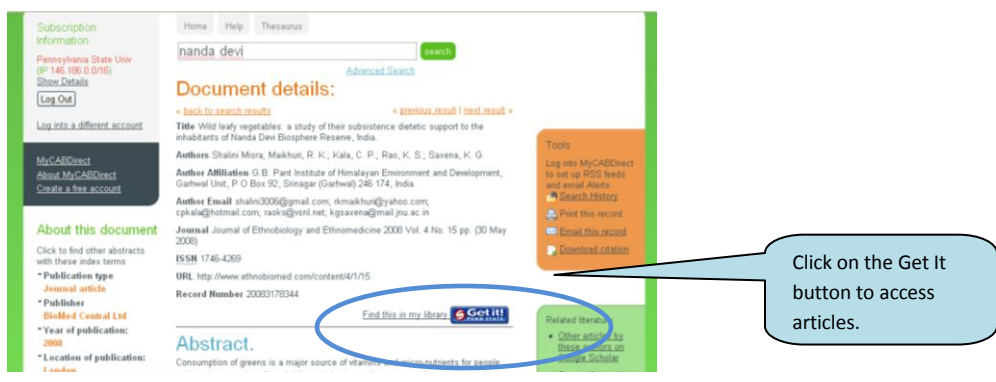
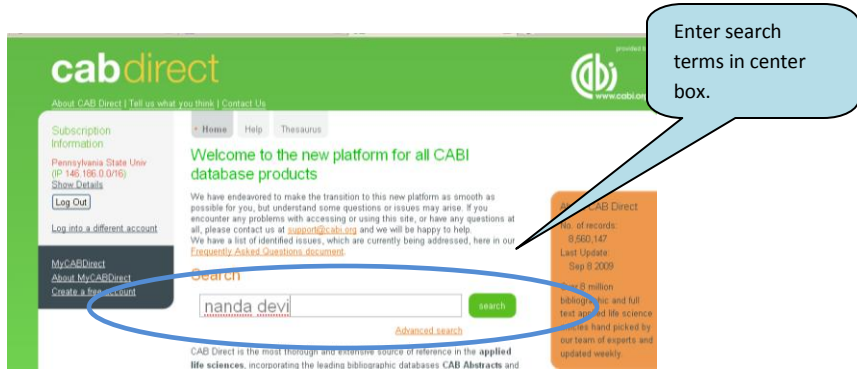

## CAB Abstracts



Look for "Online Full Text," which tells you that Penn State has access to an online version of the article. Click on GO, under Online Full Text, to access the article. If online full text access does not exist, request the item via interlibrary loan (ILL).
