

## Using Google Scholar Off Campus?

Set up Google Scholar to recognize you as a Penn State User.

### What is Google Scholar?

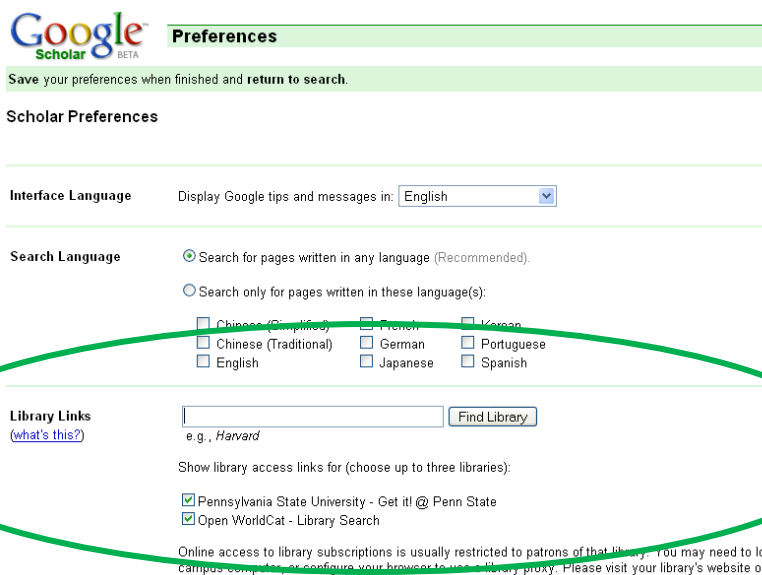
- Google Scholar is a search engine designed to find articles, books, and theses

### What you need to know about Google Scholar:

- Google Scholar does not include all scholarly resources or even all of the library resources- searching Google Scholar will return only a fraction of what the library has to offer.
  - o To access all that the Penn State University Libraries has to offer go to [www.libraries.psu.edu](http://www.libraries.psu.edu)
- Google Scholar can be a great way to find articles that are open access- i.e. articles that are freely available on the web.



To view sources available at PSU libraries from off campus, configure your Scholar Preferences to indicate that you are affiliated with Penn State.



Search for Penn State University, under library links. Select Penn State as your default library. You will now be able to view the "Get It at Penn State" links when you search Google Scholar. This allows you full access to all of the articles Penn State has within the library system- Tons of Information for your research.
