

CONDITIONS FOR THE USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC COPIES

The Pennsylvania State University Libraries

1. Patrons are permitted to use the photographic copy or digital image only once, and only for the purpose explained in the "Statement of Intended Use." Any subsequent or different use (including subsequent editions, book club editions, paperback editions, different languages, etc.) constitutes a re-use and must be applied for in writing.
2. Web pages will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
3. To credit properly, please use the following institutional identification and credit line:

When provided, the following must also be included in the credit line: unit name, collection name, author and book title, negative numbers, and the photographer's name, if applicable or if known. **IT IS MANDATORY THAT YOU CREDIT AS SPECIFIED.**

- a. With printed matter, the credit line must appear on the same or facing page as the image. Crediting of each individual item is mandatory in all cases.
 - b. With moving images, include the credit with the other "Sources of Illustrations."
 - c. With exhibitions, credit within exhibition area.
 - d. With Web pages, the credit line must appear on the same page as the image. When provided, the following must also be included in the credit line: unit name, collection name, author and book title, negative numbers, and the photographer's name, if applicable or if known. **IT IS MANDATORY THAT YOU CREDIT AS SPECIFIED.**
4. To give the Pennsylvania State University Libraries one complimentary copy of any published work in which the images appear.
 5. Not to permit others to reproduce the photographic copy or any facsimile of it.
 6. Not to reproduce the photographic copy as a dust jacket, endpaper, or to use in an advertisement or any commercial use whatsoever, nor to mass-produce as unbound material without specific permission to do so.
 7. In authorizing the publication of a photographic copy, The Pennsylvania State University Libraries does not surrender its own right to publish it, or to grant permission to others to do so.

Applicants assume all responsibility for questions of copyright and invasion of privacy that may arise in copying and in the use that is made of the images copied.
9. The Pennsylvania State University Libraries reserves the right to limit the number of images copied and to restrict the use or reproduction of rare or valuable material.
10. Any exceptions or additions to the above conditions will appear on, and be considered part of, this agreement.
11. Under certain circumstances, commercial use policies, procedures, and fees will be enforced.
