Concordance of Monuments in History of Landscape Architecture Texts

As a method of identifying a core collection of monuments for teaching the history of landscape architecture, a concordance was constructed, listing the roughly 2000 monuments illustrated in a selection of 12 books that survey broad eras and areas. The books were selected for their relevance to landscape history in general and the coursework at Penn State in particular.
